## Clarify the Conflict

Identify the causes of conflict (4 causes)

• Identify the issues (personal or substantive)

• Identify the responses to conflict (Slippery Slope)



#### Understand the Heart

Learn James 4:1-4 & Luke 6:43-45 ("Conflict starts in heart.")

• Understand issues, positions, and interests

• Identify desires/interests (Proverbs 20:5; Philippians 2:3-4)

Test Desires - Reject evil & embrace good (1 Thess. 5:21-22)

- Brainstorm options & Evaluate objectively
- → Ruild solutions from shared interests
